**RCW 42.56.360(1)(c) QUALITY IMPROVEMENT**

(1) The following health care information is exempt from disclosure under this chapter: (c) Information and documents created specifically for, and collected and maintained by a quality improvement committee under RCW 43.70.510 or 70.41.200, or by a peer review committee under RCW 4.24.250, regardless of which agency is in possession of the information and documents.
